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Introduction

Within this register, edison365 identifies any opportunities and risks to environmental management. This register is reviewed at least bi-annually or at any time where risks need to be monitored.

Carbon Footprint

- The company will, where possible, support and engage with initiatives and partnerships that focus on carbon emission reduction.
- The company will ensure to reduce carbon emissions by enabling all staff and contractors to work from home, reducing travel requirements.
